WRITING Fashion Revue COMMENTARIES

- ◆ A commentary should be brisk, to the point, and informative.
- ◆ Commentary is meant to explain the outfit you are wearing. Speak to the style of the garment, fiber content, fabric, color (especially color harmony), and accessories. Comment on why all these things make this garment suitable for you.

- ◆ If you've purchased pieces of the outfit, it's important to speak about purchased items, but emphasis for the majority of your commentary should be on the items you have personally constructed.
- ◆ Do not write commentary in the first person. Keep in mind that someone else will be reading the commentary during the revue.
- ◆ Include in the commentary only information about the outfit—not a lot of fill about the work you do in the county. However, it's important to include things about your personality and the activities that make this particular outfit appropriate for you.
- ◆ Please remember to include information about your county of residence in your commentary. It's really not important to mention the name of your club, as it's really not something of interest to the State Fair audience.
- ◆ Your full name should be included in first or second sentence. If necessary, put in phonetic spelling for difficult or unusual names to help Emcee as they announce you.
- ◆ Commentaries should be interesting and grammatically correct.

State Fashion Revue Guidelines for Purchased Garments for Models

Garments and/or commentary should not promote a particular company or store.

Information should be included in the commentary that will explain the consumer skills involved in completing the outfit.

- a) Cost of outfit - include itemized comparison of what it would cost to make the outfit.
- b) Why outfit was purchased.
- c) How outfit fits into wardrobe.
- d) Fabric structure (optional).
- e) Fiber content and care.
- f) Accessories selected.
- g) Analysis of garment construction for intended purpose.
- h) Estimated cost per wearing (cost and estimated times to be worn for one year).

We will leave it to each county's discretion as to whether or not to send teens from your county. If you feel that your county has a strong consumer-clothing program in place, you may wish to take advantage of this opportunity.
